SCOPE OF POSITION

The PGNFC requires a full time 35 Hrs. per Week Support Worker with the Aboriginal Child & Youth Wellness Program based in Prince George, who will report to the Coordinator of ACYWP Program. The team provides holistic services to primarily Aboriginal people. The position includes working as part of a multi-disciplinary team, offering support for emotional, mental, physical and spiritual health. The role includes crisis intervention, referral and advocacy, individual outreach counselling, facilitating cultural connections, group facilitation, case management and other supportive services

QUALIFICATIONS

- BSW, BA (Psychology, Social Work or Child and Youth Care), or comparable degree.
- 2 years' experience delivering prevention, early intervention or risk reduction programs to Aboriginal children, youth, and their families.
- Experience in counselling, crisis intervention and group facilitation.
- Familiarity with Aboriginal teachings and practices.
- Ability to work independently and as a team member.
- Ability to build relationships with the professional community.
- Oral, written communication and computer literacy skills.
- Criminal record check is a requirement.

DUTIES

The range of duties is varied, but at a minimum will include:

- Develop and deliver culturally relevant, prevention, wellness and risk reduction activities to children and youth, including advocacy, individual counselling, workshops, groups and camps.
- Provide liaison, consultative and education services to other service providers and parents on behalf of Aboriginal clients.
- Facilitate access to assessment services as needed.
- Facilitate access to services for children, youth and families
- Participate in local cultural and healing practices, and work from an Aboriginal model of wellness.
- Other duties, as required.
