The Prince George Native Friendship Centre (PGNFC) requires a Speech-Language Pathologist which will provide a range of clinical services that focus on promoting communication, language and speech and that contribute to a client/patient's overall cognitive, physical, social and emotional well-being. The Speech-Language Pathologist works closely with babies, children who have various levels of speech, language and communication problems. The successful candidate will provide assessments and intervention to children (0-6 years old) who are referred to the PGNFC Speech and Language Program and will report directly to the Director of Early Childhood Services.

- Advanced training and expertise in specialty area (preferred);
- Experience working in an Early Childhood Development is asset;
